Dear Chairman Hansen & Assembly Judiciary Committee,


The Nevada Firearms Coalition has reviewed SB 240 and has the following comments:

Page 18. lines 33-37, 36. regarding the an amendment to NRS 3202.362 The word “purchase” and “transfer” is used, however, NRS 202.253 which is the definitions section for NRS 202.253 to NRS 202.369 inclusive does not define transfer nor purchase. To clarify this issue, we propose an amendment to NRS 202.253 to include the definition of Purchase as “the transfer of ownership in accordance with NRS 372.050.” and Transfer as “the transfer of ownership in accordance with NRS 372.050” If not defined, the terms “purchase” and “transfer” are left up to discretionary determination and may provide issues with enforcement of this legislation. For instance if someone allows another person to shoot their firearm at the shooting range, does that constitute a “transfer”? It appears that the transfer refers to “transfer of ownership” and “purchase” and “sell” are both common terms referring to transfer of ownership. For clarification, we think it is important that these terms are defined in the definition section of this NRS section.

Nevada Firearms Coalition supports this legislation and strongly urges this amendment.
